<p>Presentation of the Speaker</p>	<p>Christophe NUTTALL is a PHD in human science in the field of development.</p> <p>After having worked at CNES (French spatial Agency) and the French ministry of foreign affairs, Christophe Nuttall joined UNITAR in 1993 in charge of information society. Since the World Summit on Sustainable Development (2002) he developed the decentralization cooperation programme at UNITAR (United Nations Institute for Training and research) where he has developed a network of training center for local actors, among which CIFAL Bilbao and Shanghai for information society. He has developed a number of PPP with ALCATEL and HP in the field of information society.</p> <p>Since August 2005 he joined UNDP where he is the Director for Innovative partnerships. He is in charge within UNDP of the development of cooperation between local authorities and the UN in general, UNDP in particular, considering PPP with the private sector acting at local level.</p>
