Executive summary of the presentation	<p>Telemedicine contributes to the urban and regional planning development within the framework of medicosocial by providing the whole population with the same quality of service in the whole area. The department of the Alpes Maritimes takes the opportunity of its favourable geographical distribution of both population and medical resources to develop the telemedicine. The Medicin@pays project has connected for 2 years the 6 hospitals of the highland to the 4 hospitals of Nice city, by means of satellite devices (Alcatel Alenia Space). This experience proved that the e-training came up to the doctors and paramedics expectations. This first step favours the medical exchanges between medical teams. At the beginning of the second year, the tele-expertise experiences were based on cases in the in the domains of the psychiatry, fight against pain, first aid and geriatrics. At this purpose, a website was designed to manage the secured information transfer, common agenda, forum, etc.</p> <p>This program will go on so as to meet the local demand even better, and to extend to additional organisations such as retirement homes, medical homes, schools, etc.</p>
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
